



Install Checklist

Please initial once completed.

_____ Create a clear path throughout the appropriate areas to allow easy access for installation.

_____ Cover any furniture, vents, or areas, especially the installation areas, if you wish to minimize the obtainment of dust and debris.

_____ Remove all items from the cabinets.

_____ Remove all breakable items, such as mirrors, vases, lamps, wall hangings, etc., from install areas.

_____ You or a representative (age 18 or older) are present to answer questions and approve all project-related details during the installation.

_____ Children and pets are away from the installation areas.

_____ Disconnect and remove all plumbing. Turn off/unplug and remove stoves/ranges/ovens.

_____ The final painting/covering of walls should not be done until after installation, if possible. Atlantic Granite takes pride in treating every home like its own; however, scrapes, dings, and punctures on the wall and cabinets are likely to happen. *These are incidental damages and are the customer's responsibility to fix.*

_____ Final Payment is prepared for after the completion of the installation.

Atlantic Granite's installers will review the items below. It is at the discretion of the installers whether or not the requirements were met by the customer (see Customer Agreement Form). If the terms are incomplete, the customer must reschedule a new install date and pay an additional installation fee.
